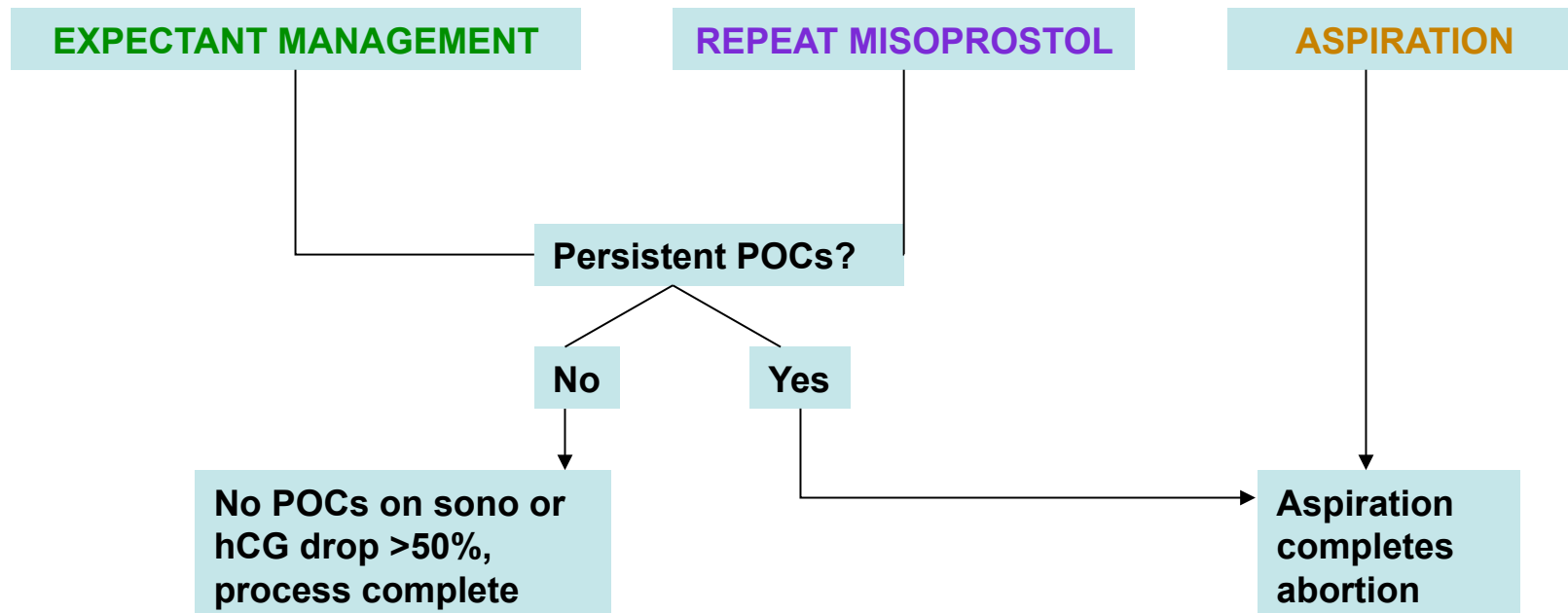


Options for Ongoing Pregnancy or Retained Gestational Sac on Ultrasound After Medication Abortion* (which occurs <1% of the time)

Pregnancy without FH or with retained sac only: Offer **EXPECTANT MANAGEMENT**, **REPEAT MISOPROSTOL ****, or **ASPIRATION**

Pregnancy with FH ≤ 9 weeks: Offer **REPEAT MISOPROSTOL **** or **ASPIRATION**

Pregnancy with FH > 9 weeks: Recommend **ASPIRATION**



*Ultrasound is not routinely needed for a medication abortion. An ultrasound is indicated if the follow-up Beta hCG does not drop more than 50% or if the history makes you suspicious that the pregnancy was not expelled. Thickened, heterogeneous endometrium is normal ultrasound finding post med ab.

**Repeating misoprostol 800mcg is successful about 85% of the time.
