



Project ACCESS Virtual Learning Collaborative (VLC): Integrating Medication Abortion and Early Pregnancy Loss Care into Primary Care

Please join the Reproductive Health Access Project (RHAP) and the Primary Care Development Corporation (PCDC) for the Project ACCESS (Abortion Care Clinical Expansion and Early Pregnancy Loss Support Series) VLC, focusing on expanding patient access to comprehensive and high quality sexual and reproductive health, including medication abortion and early pregnancy loss care (EPL), in primary care settings. <u>We're hosting an information session on</u> <u>February 23rd at 1pm ET / 10 am PT via Zoom</u>.

The VLC will offer participating primary care organizations intensive technical assistance and training. This includes:

- Building buy-in for EPL and abortion care among leadership
- Setting up appropriate clinical, financial, and administrative systems
- Training in pregnancy options counseling, medication management of EPL, medication abortion, telehealth, etc
- Identifying community supports and resources, including malpractice and legal experts
- Networking with a community of others engaged in similar work

Through the Project ACCESS VLC, we aim for participating sites to be able to provide medication management of EPL and medication abortion, and/or to be prepared to work through next steps in the process. VLC participants will meet monthly over Zoom for one year with facilitators and colleagues throughout the country to identify shared needs and goals, develop work plans, track progress, and discuss strategies to overcome common barriers. RHAP and PCDC will also provide technical assistance and support outside of monthly sessions, as needed. **Participating health centers will receive a stipend of \$9,000.**

Who Can Participate?

Federally Qualified Health Centers (FHQCs) and other community-based primary care providers in states that meet the following criteria are welcome to apply:

- 1. Abortion access in your state is likely to be secure.
- 2. Abortion and EPL care are feasible in primary care.
- 3. The health center can commit time for a team of champions to attend monthly virtual meetings and to develop short and long-term goals for their organization in conjunction with leadership.
