

# Coding for Vasectomies

ICD-10 Code	Description
<b>Z30.09</b>	Encounter for other general counseling and advice on contraception ( <i>applicable to consultation</i> )
<b>Z30.2</b>	Encounter for sterilization ( <i>applicable to confirmed surgery</i> )
<b>Z30.8</b>	Encounter for other contraceptive management ( <i>applicable to post-vasectomy sperm count</i> )
<b>Z30.40</b>	Encounter for surveillance of contraceptives
<b>Z98.52</b>	Vasectomy status

CPT Code	Description
<b>55250</b>	Encounter Vasectomy, unilateral or bilateral (separate procedure), including postoperative semen examination(s)
<b>89321</b>	Semen analysis, presence and/or mobility of sperm ( <i>applicable only if vasectomy performed elsewhere</i> )
<b>G0027</b>	Semen analysis, presence and/or motility of sperm excluding Huhner ( <i>if performing in clinic/office, only if vasectomy is performed elsewhere</i> )
<b>A4267</b>	Condoms ( <i>external only</i> )
<b>A4550</b>	Surgical trays
<b>99070</b>	Supplies and materials (except spectacles), provided over and above those usually included with the office visit or other services rendered (list drugs, trays, supplies, or materials provided)

## Evaluation and Management (E/M) Codes

New (99202 – 99205) and established (99212 – 99215) client code selection is based on medical decision making (MDM) level OR time. Use the method most appropriate for the care given and results in the highest level code supported in the documentation.

E/M Code	Problems	Data	Risk
<b>99202; 99212</b>	Minimal	Minimal or none	Minimal risk of morbidity
<b>99203; 99213</b>	Low	Limited	Low risk of morbidity
<b>99204; 99214</b>	Moderate	Moderate	Moderate
<b>99205; 99215</b>	High	Extensive	High risk of morbidity

New Patient	Time
<b>99202</b>	15-29 min
<b>99203</b>	30-44 min
<b>99204</b>	45-59 min
<b>99205</b>	60-74 min

Modifiers	Description
<b>-25</b>	Use with the appropriate E/M code to indicate that significant and separately identifiable E/M was provided on the same date of service as a procedure
<b>-95</b>	Use with the appropriate E/M code to indicate a real-time audio and video telehealth visit

<b>99212</b>	10-19 min
<b>99213</b>	20-29 min
<b>99214</b>	30-39 min
<b>99215</b>	40-54 min
