

DELINEATION OF PRIVILEGES IN ABORTION PROCEDURES

Clinicians requesting privileges in aspiration abortion procedures need to meet the following requirements:

- 1. Current member of the clinical department in good standing.
- 2. Documentation of training in abortion procedures by a recognized training program. Recognized are listed below.*
- 3. Maintaining these privileges requires providing the department with regular reports for the department’s quality improvement program.

I. Manual Vacuum Aspiration (MVA)

Clinicians requesting these privileges must provide documentation of a minimum of 50 MVAs. Privileges for this procedure will be granted only after the clinician has performed 2 successful procedures under the direct supervision of a clinician designated by this department’s chair.

II. Using Ultrasonography in the Assessment of Medication Abortions.

Clinicians requesting this procedure must provide documentation of a minimum of 30 ultrasound exams. These limited study sonograms need to include the dating of the first trimester of the pregnancy and follow-up of early spontaneous or induced abortions. Clinicians will be observed for the performance of a minimum of 2 sonograms by an appropriately designated clinician. Granting this privilege is subject to the review of the department chair.
