IUD Insertion Set-up Requirements

The SBHC will need the following items to implement IUD insertions into clinic services:

- 1. IUD (Mirena, Paragard and Skyla)
- Insertion instruments (the number of sets will depend on the number of insertions that will be made available and if sterilization procedures occur onsite or offsite)
 - a. 6 sets of sterile instruments required for 2-3 insertions per week, assuming autoclave is off-site. Each set should include the following items:
 - i. One tenaculum
 - ii. One small Graves speculum
 - iii. One pair of long, curved scissors
 - iv. One sponge forceps
 - v. Uterine sound (disposable or reusable)
 - vi. Betadine swabs (or betadine and sterile 4x4's)
- 3. Sterile Gloves
- 4. Chux and sterile drapes (one chuck for the instrument tray and one for the exam table)
- 5. Sanitary napkins for the patient post-procedure
- 6. If autoclaving on site: autoclaving bags, indicator strips, and autoclave tape
- 7. External light source (such as a free-standing gooseneck lamp)
